## GOVERNMENT STIMULUS CHECK PAYMENTS

**Track Your Stimulus Check,** [www.irs.gov/coronavirus/get-my-payment](http://www.irs.gov/coronavirus/get-my-payment)

Eligible taxpayers who filed a tax return for either 2019 or 2018 will automatically receive payments of up to \$1,200 for individuals or \$2,400 for married couples. Parents also receive \$500 for each child under 17. Use the link to check your payment status, confirm payment type (direct deposit or check), and enter bank information for direct deposit if the IRS doesn't have it.

### Social Security and Disability Recipients

If you receive Social Security, disability (SSDI), or survivor benefits, as well as Railroad Retirement and survivor benefits, you do not need to take any further action. The IRS already has your information and you will receive \$1,200.

### Non-Filers - visit [www.irs.gov/coronavirus/non-filers-enter-payment-info-here](http://www.irs.gov/coronavirus/non-filers-enter-payment-info-here)

If you don't file taxes, the IRS is asking you to provide simple information so you can get your payment. You should provide this information if:

- You did not file a 2018 or 2019 federal income tax return because your gross income was under \$12,200 or \$24,400 for married couples. This includes people who had no income. Or
- You weren't required to file a 2018 or 2019 federal income tax return for other reasons

### Recently Moved

For security reasons, the IRS plans to mail a letter about the stimulus check payment to the taxpayer's last known address within 15 days after the payment is paid. The letter will provide information on how the payment was made and how to report any failure to receive the payment. If the tax payer is unsure they're receiving a legitimate letter, the IRS urges taxpayers to visit IRS.gov first to protect against scams.
