Eligible taxpayers who filed tax returns for either 2019 or 2018 will automatically
recieve payments of up to \$1,200 for individuals or \$2,400 for married couples.

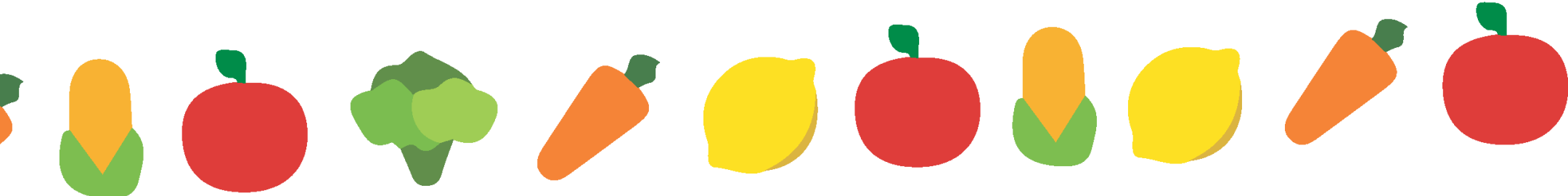

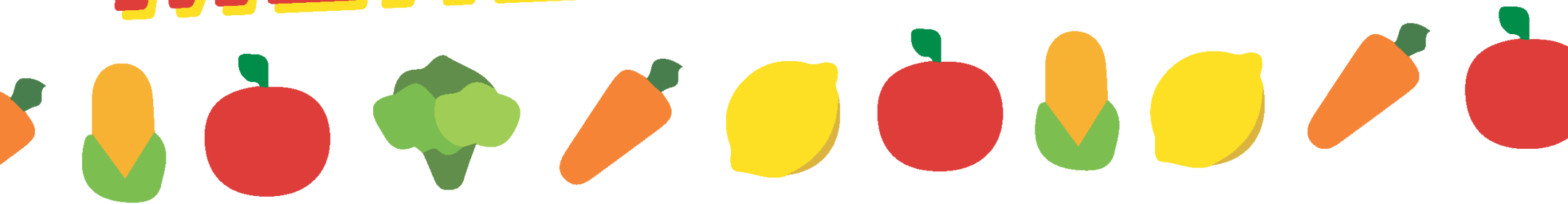
