REOPENING & SAFETY

Moving Milwaukee Forward Safely enters Phase 3

Here's what that means:

- Businesses can now operate at 50% of building capacity
- Bars and restaurants can open for indoors service at 25% of building capacity. Outdoor dining will be allowed with precautions, and can be expanded under the City's proposed Active Streets for Business program.
- Public and private gatherings will be allowed at 25% of building capacity.
- Salons and barbershops, because of close contact, will be kept at 25% of building capacity, with a one-to-one customer to staff ratio.
- Child care centers and youth summer programs will be allowed to operate at 50% building capacity.
- 250 is the maximum limit on people allowed in any gathering, indoor or outdoor, regardless of building capacity
- All businesses and public or private gatherings are subject to distancing requirements and businesses must implement safe business practices.
