RENT & ENERGY ASSISTANCE

- **Community Advocates (CA)** - CA's Rental Housing Resource Center in partnership with the Milwaukee County Eviction Prevention Funds assist Milwaukee County residents in need of one-time rental assistance. Applicants may be eligible for up to \$3,000. Criteria are:
 - Experienced loss of income in last 60 days or due to COVID-19
 - Complete Pre-Application at bit.ly/ca-rent-assistance-app
- **Wisconsin Rent Assistance Program (WRAP)** - The Social Development Commission (SDC) is accepting applications for residents of Milwaukee, Washington, and Ozaukee counties who have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - Filling out an application online is the best and easiest way to get in contact with SDC about the WRAP program. For eligibility info and to fill out an application visit bit.ly/sdc-wrap
 - If you do not have access to a computer, please call (414)326-2888
- **Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP)** - The Department of Administration (DOA) has adjusted the eligibility requirements for residents who are seeking heating and electric assistance due to COVID-19.
 - Eligibility now based on the household's previous month of income, rather than the previous three months of income.

Milwaukee Mask Mandate

The City of Milwaukee has issued a mask ordinance that went into effect July 16th, 2020. Masks are required by all persons over the age of 3 in the city. You can pick up FREE masks here: 841 N. Broadway; 3200 N. 36th St; 7630 W. Mill Rd; or 1639 S. 23rd St. Monday - Friday until 1:00pm. Up to 3 masks per person.

Moving Milwaukee Forward Safely is in Phase 4.1 - school update included

While in Phase 4.1, schools must have an approved safety plan before reopening for in-person instruction. Read the Health Department's guidance for schools at city.milwaukee.gov/MMFS/Schools. Businesses are allowed to open for in-person service. Occupancy and guidelines vary for different business types and status updates are given weekly.
